Collection of Lithium-ion and Other Batteries with Small Metal Items!

In recent years, there have been frequent fires caused by lithium-ion and other batteries mixed in with regular garbage. We ask for your cooperation in properly separating your garbage.



Starting month:

November, 2025

Collection dates:

Small metal items collection day (twice a month)

*See the Kawasaki City website for the collection dates

Applicable items:

Rechargeable batteries used at home

(lithium-ion batteries and mobile batteries, etc.)



*This includes devices for which the batteries cannot be removed from the main unit



*Please put out dry cell batteries and lithium coin batteries for collection with used dry cell batteries as usual.

Not applicable

Automobile batteries, personal computer main units and portable power supplies




*We will collect batteries removed from computers

How to throw away

① Please insulate the **terminals** by affixing **transparent tape** to them



② Please place the batteries in a transparent bag, **Rechargeable Batteries** **label the bag as “じゅうでんち”** and then put it out for collection at the resources collection point.



*Please separate **swollen or deformed** rechargeable batteries from other batteries, **label the bag as**

Deformed Batteries
“**じゅうでんちへんけい**” and then put it out for collection at the resources collection point.



*If the longest point of an item is **30 cm or more** please dispose of it as “**oversized garbage**”
