

About childbirth and childcare support project

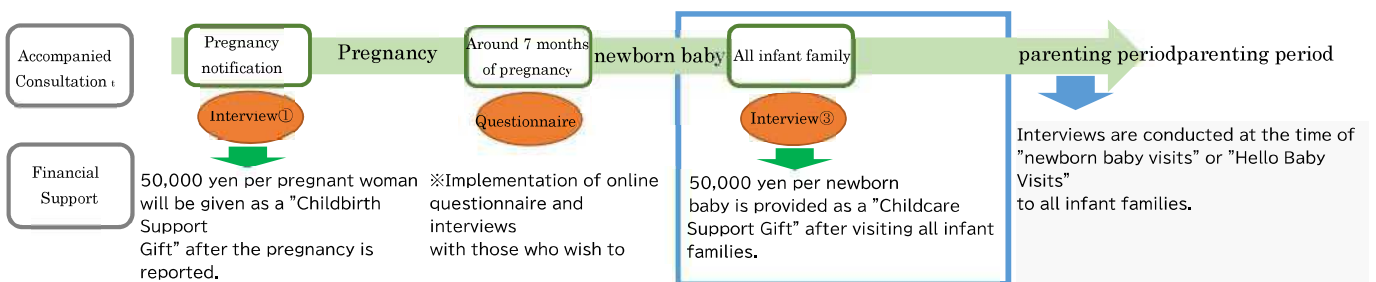
(Payment of support money)

Kawasaki City has decided to launch the "childbirth and childcare support project" to provide support from the time of pregnancy to childbirth and child rearing.

The "childbirth and childcare support project" will provide Accompanied Consultation Support to pregnant women and families raising children, especially those between the ages of 0 and 2, by interviewing them and providing information. After conducting interviews and questionnaires on child rearing, we will provide financial support in the form of childbirth support gifts and Childcare Support Gifts.

■ Accompanied Consultation Support and financial support flow in childbirth and childcare support project



- Accompanied Consultation Support,
 - [Pregnancy notification] All interviews by professionals at the time of pregnancy notification
 - [Around 7 months of pregnancy] Implementation of online questionnaire and interviews with those who wish to receive consultation, etc.
 - [All infant family visits (after delivery)] Interviews are conducted at the time of "newborn baby visits" or "Hello Baby Visits" to all infant families.

- Financial Support
 - 50,000 yen per pregnant woman will be given as a "Childbirth Support Gift" after the pregnancy is reported.
 - 50,000 yen per newborn baby is provided as a "Childcare Support Gift" after visiting all infant families.

■ Subject of payment and details of payment

Those who are taking care of a **newborn baby born on or after March 1, 2023**, who have reported the birth to Kawasaki City and who have received a newborn baby visitation, etc.

→Each newborn baby will receive a **Childcare Support Gift of 50,000 yen.**

- *Childcare Support Gift is 50,000 yen per newborn (total of 100,000 yen for twins).
- *In the case of multiple births (twins, triplets, etc.), please enter all eligible newborns in a single application for the support gift.
- *The applicant and beneficiary of the gift must be the caregiver of the newborns. If other persons need to apply, please contact the call center.



■ How to Apply

Support gift application from the website
(Accessed from the 2D code on the right)

*If you wish to receive both a newborn baby visit and a "Hello Baby" visit, please submit only one application from the application received earlier.

*Please submit documents that can verify the applicant's identity, information on the account to which the money is to be transferred (bankbook, cash card, etc.), and mother and child health insurance card (if applicable). (Please have your mother's and child's health handbook ready at hand before applying.

■ Application Deadline

Within 3 months of newborn child's visit

*It may take some time for payment (up to 4 months after application), so please apply as soon as possible. Please note that we may not be able to provide the support gift if the application deadline has passed.

*The same applies if you received the Childbirth Support Gift in another city.

■ Notes on application

- If you have received childbirth and childcare support money from another municipality, you cannot apply. If there is a possibility of double application, or if the application is incomplete, we may contact you by phone or other means, including making inquiries to other cities.
