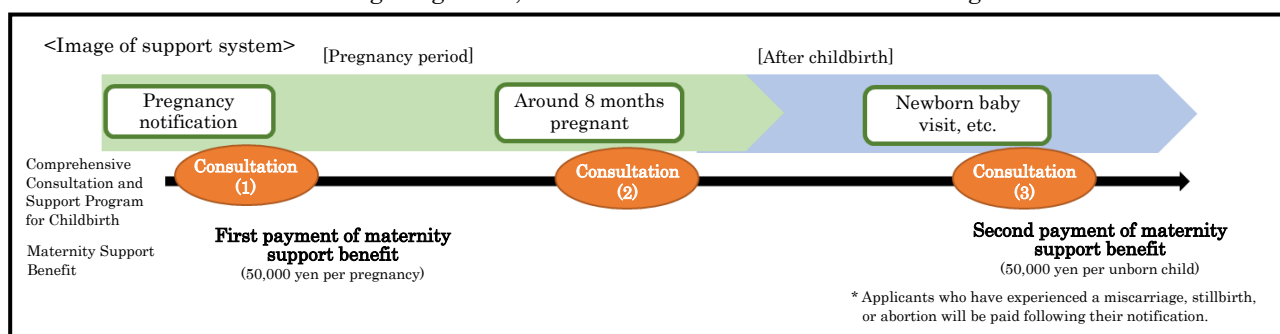


1st maternity support benefit application information

About the maternity support benefit

From April 1, 2025, the national government started programs with the aim to provide continuous support from the pregnancy period. These include the “Maternity Support Benefit” as a means of financial support as well as the “Comprehensive Consultation and Support Program for Childbirth” as a form of close-following consultation support. Kawasaki City is sending out application guides for maternity support benefit to be paid following your consultation when you submit your pregnancy notification and at the time of a visit following childbirth in order to provide comprehensive physical, mental, and financial support to mothers before and after giving birth, in line with the aim of the national government.



Eligible persons and details of first payment of maternity support benefit

Payment of **50,000 yen** for each pregnancy

* Applicants and recipients must be pregnant. Payments can only be made to the account of the pregnant person.

If there is no bank account in the name of the pregnant person, please contact the call center on the back.

* If your residence is registered in Kawasaki City and you have experienced a miscarriage, stillbirth, or abortion, you can still receive the maternity support benefit. For details, please contact the call center on the back.

Application method

You can apply via the “Kawasaki Childcare App Sukusuku”.

[Important] To apply, the following image data will be required. Please prepare these items before applying.

Documents to confirm personal identity	ID (driver's license, My Number card, residence card, etc.)
Documents to confirm pregnancy * One of (1) to (4) is required.	(1) Receipt and detailed statement at the time pregnancy was confirmed (2) Receipt and detailed statement for the maternal health check-up (3) The cover of the Maternal and Child Health Handbook showing the pregnant woman's name, and the page with results recorded for pregnancy check-ups during pregnancy (Maternal and Child Health Handbook P8, P9) (4) Document certifying pregnancy issued by an obstetric medical institution
Documents to confirm the transfer account	Documents showing the pregnant woman's account number (bankbook, cash card, etc.)

■ Application deadline

2 years from the date on which you confirmed that you are pregnant

- * "Date on which you confirmed that you are pregnant" refers to the date on which a fetal heartbeat was confirmed by an obstetrician.
- * You are able to apply by the application deadline. However, in the future, we do not plan to send out application recommendation notices individually. Therefore, we recommend that you apply as soon as possible.

The first maternity support benefit may not be paid after the application deadline.

■ Estimated period of time until payment

Following your application, it may take up to 3 months for you to receive your payment.

Before the money is transferred to your bank account, the "Maternity Support Benefit Confirmation Notice and Maternity Support Benefit Payment Notice" will be sent to your home by post.

■ Precautions when submitting application

An application cannot be submitted if you have already received the first maternity support benefit from Kawasaki City or another municipality.

We may contact you by telephone or contact other municipalities, if there is the possibility of a duplicate application or incorrect details in your application. A medical institution may also verify the state of your pregnancy.
