## What is the Kawasaki Children's Rights Ordinance?

Enacted in 2001, the Kawasaki Children's Rights Ordinance is rooted in the principles of the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child. Kawasaki was the first municipality in Japan to enact such an ordinance. The ordinance was enacted with the aim of having children cherished and protected as individuals, and enabling them to live in ways that are true to themselves.
