Regardless of nationality, all registered residents of Japan aged 20-59 are obligated to enroll in the National Pension System. If you don't make the payments, you cannot get pension benefits when you turn 65 years old or in the case of an accident. Should it be difficult to make National Pension Insurance payments, please consult with your local ward office or branch office.
