

Learn About Disaster Preparedness Together with Japanese Residents

We will all take part in a disaster preparedness drill organized by the local neighborhood association. Since Chinese, Vietnamese, Filipino, and English speakers will also be joining, people who are not confident in Japanese can also participate.

(1) Experience an earthquake simulator vehicle.



(2) Experience what to do when smoke makes it difficult to see during a fire.



(3) Experience the water pressure of a fire hose used to extinguish fires.



(4) Learn how to use a fire extinguisher.



(5) Learn how to use a triangular bandage, which can be used for first aid or as a mask.

(6) Learn how to use an AED and the steps for lifesaving.



(7) Watch a video (DVD) about disaster preparedness.

AED stands for Automated External Defibrillator. It is a medical device that delivers an electric shock to restore a normal heart rhythm when the heart is in ventricular fibrillation (a state where it quivers and cannot pump blood).
